

## 2010 NATIONAL CONVENTION VOTING PROCEDURES

- Courts will send in Delegate lists by March 15, 2010, and will receive credential cards as quickly as possible.
- On the afternoon of voting Delegates will be seated on the convention floor at your designated state sign.
- On Wednesday afternoon after the convention is adjourned, State Regents, Monitors, and members of the Election Committee will attend a short meeting to ensure that they have no questions about the voting procedure.
- Final delegate registration will be on Thursday, July 15, 2010 between 9:30 AM and 11:00 AM. If you are not registered by this time you will not be allowed to vote.
- The doors to the convention floor will open to delegates at 11:45 AM on Thursday July 15, 2010. Monitors will ensure that no one is admitted except Delegates, and Election Committee members.
- The chairman of the Elections Committee will be at the microphone giving general directions and calling for silence.
- All delegates are asked to bring a pen.
- From 11:45 AM to 12:15 PM, Monitors and Election Committee will have the Delegates sign in and will mark Delegates' badges.
- A Monitor will be assigned to sign in Delegates seated on the dais.
- At 12:00 PM the doors to the convention floor will be closed, and any Delegate who is not inside will not have the opportunity to vote.
- Voting will begin as soon as all delegates have signed in, but all sign-in must be completed by 12:15 PM at which time the chairman of the Elections Committee will ask that ballots be passed out and will call, again, for silence.
- Delegates may vote for only one candidate per office and no more than 9 Candidates for Director to be valid. They need not vote for all positions open. They may not vote for more than 7 Candidates running for the 2012 National Nominating Committee.
- The Monitors and Election Committee members will pick up ballots as they are completed and take them to the ballot boxes. They will return all unused ballots. Credential sheets will be returned to Credentials Committee Members after the voting is completed.
- The Election Committee members will take the ballot boxes to the area designated for counting.
